Subject: Instructions on the prohibition of private practice by the Resident Doctors of RIMS, Imphal-regarding

No. B/3602/2024-RIMS:

In continuation of this Institute's O.M. No. B/3013/2024-RIMS dated 02.07.2024, it is informed that certain sections of Resident Doctors are indulging in private practice including visits to private Nursing Homes. Such practices may promote unethical behavior among healthcare providers, compromise patient care services in government hospitals/institutes, and set a poor example for students, potentially creating a vicious cycle.

2. It may be mentioned that Govt. Doctors are given/provided NPA in lieu of Private Practice. Hence, in order to ensure high ethical standards and for providing optimum patient care services, all Resident Doctors of RIMS, Imphal, are directed to refrain completely from engaging in any form of private practice, including consultations, laboratory services, visits to Private Nursing Homes etc.
3. Strict compliance with these instructions is expected from all Resident Doctors of RIMS, Imphal, failing which, necessary action as deemed appropriate, shall be taken against him/her in accordance with the existing rules.
4. All Heads of Departments are instructed to ensure that all Resident Doctors of RIMS, Imphal, under their supervision are informed about this Office Memorandum.
5. This issues with the approval of the Director, RIMS, Imphal.
